The City of Bakersfield is excited to announce the creation and launch of the Bakersfield Youth Jobs Program- The first The Kern Connected Community Network (KCCN) was launched in December of 2019 to help provide a smooth transition for patients, individuals, and families to community resources by utilizing the Unite Us platform.

The KCCN creates efficient linkages between hospitals, clinics, and local community organizations throughout Kern County that provide services vital to underserved populations. KCCN, powered by Unite Us, streamlines electronic referrals for social needs while also collecting data.

Founded in 2000, the Kern River Valley Heritage Foundation (KRVHF) has grown from a vision to a viable and self-sustaining non-profit organization that today has stewardship responsibilities for over 4,000 acres in the Kern River Valley.

On June 22, KRVHF and representatives from Kern County Public Works Department celebrate the new walkway through the Hot Springs Wetlands.
