

## Call for Nominations – Due February 1, 2023 2023 Judi McCarthy Woman in Philanthropy Award

The Women's and Girls' Fund is pleased to solicit nominations for the 2023 Judi McCarthy Woman in Philanthropy Award. This award is given to a woman who has made exceptional contributions of her time, talent, and treasure to improve the quality of life in Kern County.

### Selection Criteria

- Demonstrates a philanthropic spirit through personal giving or inspiring others to support charitable organizations;
- Exhibits a long-term commitment to, and a passion for, bettering the lives of Kern County residents;
- Focuses on seeking solutions to a problem rather than easing the symptoms; and
- Inspires others to take a leadership role in philanthropy.

### Selection Process:

- The Awards Committee is composed of members of the Women's and Girls' Fund Vision Committee. Any member of the Vision Committee who submits a nomination is excluded from the Awards Committee.
- The Committee reviews all nominations and selects the recipient using the selection criteria stated in the call for nominations.
- The awards are presented at the Women's and Girls' Fund Annual Luncheon. The award recipient will be notified in advance of the luncheon and will be asked to attend the luncheon to be honored.
- In the unlikely event that that no nominee has met the criteria the award may be withheld.

### Nomination Process

- Save the document using the nominee's name in the title of the file (e.g. JMcCarthy.pdf).

- Please do not send a resume. It will not be considered in the selection process.
